- **Information Update:**

- **Employee Covid-19 Survey (AK):**

- **Return to Campus Update (AK):**

- Employees are slowly returning back to work. August 17 is still a go for students returning to campus. Football is TBD.

- **Marketing and Communications (AD):**

- Amber provided an update on the projects she is currently working on. Pillar's proof is due out next week. August newsletter will go out next week.

- **Field Services Update (JS):**

- **Office of Assessments Update (MB):**
